

Passport Requirement Updated

Below is a chart of the provisions/requirements of the Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative (a/k/a "Passport Requirement") Final Rule, which came out on April 3, 2008. Please keep this document and use it as your guidance for requirements for your drivers. Note that the next deadline for this rule is June 1, 2009. Note also that some documents are still pending final approval from DHS for use at the border; we will update this chart when those approvals are completed.
